

Part-Time School Counselor

St. Thomas Aquinas Parish School is accepting resumes and cover letters for a part-time position as a school counselor. The position is responsible for preschool through 8th grade providing individual counseling services with a wide range of social and emotional difficulties affecting school functioning. In addition to counseling services, the individual would coordinate 504 plans and serve as the case coordinator for students serviced by 504 plans. The qualified individual would also organize development opportunities regarding social and emotional learning and current issues for staff and parents. Further, they would assist in engaging in consultation with teachers regarding class behavioral interventions and coordinate and advise parents regarding psychoeducational evaluations conducted outside of school, both private and through the school district.

Candidate qualifications and requirements are a Master of Education in School Counseling, a Master's Degree in School Psychology or comparable fields. Eligible candidates must pass a criminal background check and complete Protecting God's Children program, must have a strong working knowledge of the Faith, demonstrated ability with computers and other educational technology, committed to life-long learning, and the ability to communicate effectively with parents.
